## White Anemone



*Anemone 'Honorine Jobert'*

This is a vigorous, low maintenance plant that blooms white in the late summer and early fall. The basal leaves are lush and dark green that grow from a rhizomal mass in the soil. Anemones make great cut flowers and nicely complement plants of varying colors, heights and shapes. Because of the flowers' height and wide, bright petals, they make excellent pollinators and give gardens a full, vigorous look.

Average height: 24-26in.

## "Pink Carmine" Montbretia



*Crococsmia 'Carmine Pink'*

Lovely and prolific pink flowers on bright green foliage, this plant is eye catching to pollinators and garden guests alike. These Crocosmias are great garden companions, but can also thrive when grown in containers. They are drought tolerant, salt tolerant, and deer and rabbit resistant. The blooms stick around for a long time, starting in mid-summer and lasting well into the fall.

Average height: 12-16in.

## Woolly Sunflower



*Eriophyllum lanatum 'Siskiyou'*

An inland northwest native, the woolly sunflower is a hardy and vibrant flowering plant that emerges from May to June. It's silvery green foliage contrasts beautifully with many branching and prolific vibrant yellow flowers. The large blooms provide ideal pollinating plants for bees, butterflies and other insects, and the woolly sunflower serves as a larval host plant for the painted lady butterfly.

Average height: 16-18in.
