Red Sombrero Coneflower



Echinacea purpurea "Balsomsed"

The red coneflower, also called the sombrero coneflower, blooms bright red from late spring through the summer. It is a flashy, tall perennial that is attractive to pollinators and looks great in landscaping or raised garden beds. This species is *drought tolerant* and prefers partial to full sun, but prefers regular watering for full, healthy blooms. Average height: 24-26in.

Snow Lavender



Lavandula angustifolia

Fragrant and unique, white flowering lavender is a low growing shrub that will fit into an herb garden or as a companion to other perennials. Blooming in the early spring through late summer, snow lavender brings bright yellow flowers to your landscaping with the soothing scent everyone knows so well. These flowers prefer partial to full sun and are drought resistant. Their height, color and fragrance attract pollinators and add a bright statement flower to any garden. Average height: 12-16in.

Mango Tango Hyssop



Agastache "Mango Tango" hyssop

Bright orange, trumpet-shaped flowers that attract hummingbirds, butterflies, and bees.

Average height: 16-18in.

Hyssop flowers are edible and have an anise or licorice-like flavor. Try adding them to teas and drinks, salads or desserts, or just enjoy them as edible decorations.
